

Student Member

Student membership is intended for individuals who are enrolled in a post-secondary interior design education program. It offers a means for individuals to become familiar with the profession and professional associations and to interact with practioners prior to graduation.

A Student Member must make application for Membership as a Provisional Member within six months of completion of the current academic year, unless the applicant re-enrolls in a post-secondary interior design education program which is approved by Council.

A Student Member shall not be permitted to use any designation following their name to denote Membership in the Association.

A Student Member is one who meets all of the following criteria:

- is enrolled as a student in a post-secondary interior design education program that is approved by Council
- is of good character and adheres to the ethical standards of the Association, and
- pays, in full, fees, dues or levies in the Association
- A Student Member shall not be permitted to use any designation following their name to denote Membership in the Association.
- A Student Member must make application for Membership as a Provisional Member within six months of completion of the current academic year, unless the applicant re-enrolls in a postsecondary interior design education program which is approved by Council.
